i. Write the following numbers in digits:

- Three Hundred and Nine
- Six Thousand, One Hundred and Twenty Seven
- Thirty Thousand, Eight Hundred and Five
- One Million, Four Hundred and One Thousand, Six Hundred and Ninety Eight

ii. Write the following numbers in words:

- 679
- 2,390
- 56,712
- 970,171

iii. Perform the following calculations:

- $6 + 5 - 5$
- $4 \times 6 + 2$
- $9 - 1 \times 7$
- $2 + 6 \div 3$
- $12 \div 2 \div 3$
- $60 \div 4 \times 3$
- $24 \div (2 \times 4)$

iv. 33 people were on a bus. At a stop, 19 people got off and 15 people got on. How many people are now on the bus?

v. Work out 36×24 without using a calculator.

vi. Use the information that

$$322 \times 48 = 15,456$$

to find the value of:

- 3.22×4.8
- 0.322×0.48
- $15,456 \div 4.8$
